





## Platform #1: TikTok

## How to find trends on TikTok



### 1. Use the discover tab (Explore page)

Open the TikTok app

- **d** Tap the "Search" ( ) icon
- In the search bar, enter general keywords like:
- 🕑 "viral"
- 🕑 "trending sounds"
- 🕑 "template"
- 🕑 "brainrot"
- 🕑 "edit"

Scroll through results → look for repeating formats, sounds, and caption styles


## 2. Check hashtags

### Look up these consistently updated tags:



If you're seeing similar edits (same template, sound, or punchline) across multiple unrelated creators, it's peaking. **Jump on it now,** or put your own twist on it before it's saturated.

## 4. Follow niche trend pages



## Follow TikTok accounts that curate trends in your niche. Examples:

@trendalytics

@videotrendreport

Your niche-specific meme pages Al, gaming, aesthetics)

## Platform #2: YouTube Shorts

### How to find trends on YouTube

YouTube's Shorts algorithm is different, it favors consistency and retention. But trends still exist, often in the form of sound bites, thumbnail styles, and video structure.

### 1. Search your niche + "Shorts"

Go to YouTube and type in: "AI meme shorts"

"funny Shorts 2025"

"brainrot edit Shorts"

"TikTok trend on YouTube Shorts"

### Then use filters:

Sort by "Upload date" or "This week"

Look for videos with high views and short titles



### Look at Top Creators in your space

### Visit Shorts creators in your niche.Ask



Are they using a new sound?



New caption format?



Visual gimmick or running joke?

### The best-performing videos often signal the next trend wave.





Check Shorts shelf on mobile app Scroll the Shorts tab for 10–15 minutes. Look for:

Repeat formats

Similar intros

Captions that grab attention fast

Videos that loop without a hard cut

If something catches your eye twice or more in a short scroll, it's trending.

## Platform #3: Instagram Reels

### How to find trends on Reels

Instagram trends often lag slightly behind TikTok, but when something catches on, it spreads FAST.

**1. Browse the Reels tab** 

Tap the Reels icon on the Instagram home screen \_\_\_\_\_

- Scroll and observe for:
- Repeated audio clips
- Similar visual filters

Caption layouts (e.g. bold white-on-black text, cutout emojis)



## 2. Tap on trending audio

While watching a Reel, tap the audio name at the bottom



If the audio has thousands or millions of uses, it's hot

Scroll through videos using it, if they all have similar structure or punchline, that's the format you should recreate

## 3. Use Instagram's creator tools



Go to the "Create" section

Choose "Reel"  $\rightarrow$  tap the music icon

You'll see a list of suggested trending sounds

## 4. Check trend pages & hashtags



## These often show early-stage trends gaining traction.

## Pro tips (All platforms)



### **Don't just copy but remix.** Use the core trend structure, but tweak the visuals, captions, or topic to fit your niche.

### Look for "formats," not just sounds.

A trend isn't just about a viral audio. It's about the way people are using it, the template, the punchline, the pacing.

### Strike fast.

Once you see a repeat pattern, don't wait. In short-form content, being early is better than being perfect.

### 1. Brainrot generator

What it does:

Creates fast-paced, chaotic AI meme videos that loop endlessly, designed for TikTok & YouTube Shorts virality.



### Best for: Loops, glitch edits, humor, meme spam

## 2. Baby generator

#### What it does:



### Best for: : Quotes, mini stories, faceless narration



## 6. Subject to video

### What it does:

Creates a talking-head-style video by animating a single image, useful for AI-generated influencers, parody, or storytelling.



## 7. Image to video

### What it does:

Animates a static image using transitions, effects, and music, ideal for aesthetic loops or music reels.



### **Best for: :** Lo-fi edits, product videos, aesthetic reels

## 8. Text to speech

What it does:

Turns any text into AI-generated voice, great for faceless narration, memes, or storytelling content.



## 9. Text to image

What it does:

Uses AI to generate unique images based on your text prompt, great for surreal thumbnails, meme art, or visuals for short-form content.



### Best for: Thumbnails, background art, standalone memes

## 10. Image to image

#### What it does:

Takes a source image and reimagines it in a new AI-generated style, such as cartoon, cyberpunk, glitchcore, anime, oil painting, etc.

This is perfect for transforming your photos, memes, or thumbnails into new artistic variations.

### Want to Go From 0 to Viral on Autopilot?

Most beginners overcomplicate going viral. They edit for hours, guess trends, and burn out after a week. Rage bait content taps into outrage, disbelief, or opinion conflict. It's one of the fastest ways to generate comments, and the algorithm loves engagement.

### How to use it ethically:

Frame the AI as doing something controversial

Example: "I asked AI to redesign the Bible characters and now I'm going to hell"

Use bold statements that invite debate:


"AI made this better than any human ever could."

"This is what your childhood looked like through Al's eyes."

### Combine with a comment question:

"Agree or nah?" / "Too far?" / "What would you ask AI to make?"

Controversy triggers comments + shares, even if people disagree.



## 4. Master the infinite loop

TikTok and YouTube Shorts both prioritize rewatch rate.

If your video ends in a way that seamlessly loops, you double the watch time.

### How to do it:

End your video with the same frame or phrase it started with


